Sarpy County, in cooperation with the Nebraska Department of Roads and the Federal Highway Administration will hold a public information meeting regarding a proposed interchange along I-80 near Pflug Road in Sarpy County.

The proposed project, identified as DPS-7914(1), CN-22228, is in the initial stages of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Interchange Justification Report (IJR) to study construction of an interchange on US Interstate Highway 80 (I-80) at the location of the existing Pflug Road overpass in Sarpy County approximately three miles east of the Platte River Bridge.

The public is invited to stop at the public meeting location at anytime from 4:00-7:00 p.m. for an informal discussion of any aspect of the project.
